DR. TED KECK Director of Athletics

This year might well be called COACH ANDY MacDONALD'S "harvest year," as it is the culmination of his recruiting efforts over the past two-and-a-half years since taking over in the spring of 1965. He expects to have his best team since his arrival here.

Before taking over as head coach at NAU, MacDonald was backfield coach and chief recruiter at State University of Iowa. He coached nine years at Flint Northern High School in Michigan before joining the staff at Iowa.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR TED KECK is a fiveyear veteran at NAU. He also directs the physical education division at NAU. Prior to coming to NAU he was athletic director at Minot State, Minot. North Dakota.

At Minot State, Dr. Keck coached football and baseball, and in 1954 his football team won the NDIAC championship. He also coached baseball, and during his seven year's tenure as baseball coach, his teams dominated the conference.



OWEN DEJANOVICH begins his second year as assistant to Andy MacDonald. "Oats" was an outstanding lineman on the 1962-63 Lumberjack football teams. He made junior college All-America at Thornton J. C.



GLEN RIGGERT is a newcomer to the Lumberjack coaching staff. This spring he finished his M.A. degree at Utah State, where he assisted Tony Knap last year.

Riggert played collegiate ball at Fresno State under Cecil Coleman, and was a member of the undefeated Fresno State team which played in the Mercy Bowl in 1961.



BILL KAUTH is a two-year veteran as head trainer for the Northern Arizona University Lumberjack athletic teams. He received his M.S. degree in physical education at Indiana State University where he also served as assistant trainer

HOWARD WHITE DR. JOSEPH DICKSON Head Coach Director of Athletics

HEAD FOOTBALL COACH Howard White is a newcomer to Eastern New Mexico University. Formerly with the University of California at Berkeley as assistant football coach, White brings an impressive high school and junior college coaching record to Eastern. In eight years as coach on the high school and junior college levels, he compiled a record of 58 wins, 16 losses, and three ties. It also includes five championship titles. In addition to three years as assistant at California, White served on the staff of Warren Woodson at New Mexico State and with Joe Kerbel at West Texas State.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR - Dr. Joseph Dickson succeeded Al Garten as director of athletics a number of years ago. Dr. Dickson is a veteran coach at Eastern New Mexico and currently is golf coach. He is a graduate of Indiana State, and has been active in NAIA District 7 affairs and is currently chairman of District 7.

TODAY'S GAME

The unexpected always seems to happen when the Northern Arizona University Lumberjacks tangle with the Greyhounds of Eastern New Mexico University, especially in the Greyhound camp. Last year at Portales, the Lumberiacks had to come from behind in the fourth period to take a 21-14 win over the Greyhounds, the first in five attempts.

At home the Lumberjacks have the edge, winning every game since 1953 to balance the winloss record with Eastern at 6-6.

Last week both the Lumberjacks and the Greyhounds felt the sting of a defeat. The Lumberjacks were edged out by Weber State 29-28, and the Greyhounds inaugurated Coach Howard White's first year with a stinging 34-0 loss to Sul Ross State.

Against Weber the Lumberjacks suffered injuries to such key linemen as defensive tackle Larry Small and offensive tackle Dennis Kiefer, and both will be sidelined today.

The Greyhounds are rebuilding this season with a host of freshmen and junior college transfers filling the many gaps open with only six returning lettermen - but then these Greyhounds can always come up with the big play!
