AXERS HERE FOR REVENGE

There is no cause for rejoicing in the Whittier Poet football camp, despite a gratifying 26-14 conquest of Cal Poly which evened the season's record at 1-1. The reason is basic: Northern Arizona is here today, looking for a whipping boy on which to lay last week's frustrating 7-0 upset to Eastern New Mexico.

The Lumberjacks remember something else, too. Andy MacDonald arrived on the Flagstaff campus at the beginning of the 1965 season and was confronted by the Whittier Poets in his baptismal outing. Whittier spent most of the evening warding off Lumberjack threats and finally slipped off the field, a 3 - 2 winner.

Northern Arizona features a wide-open "Roving I" offense under MacDonald, a former assistant at the University of Iowa. Not surprisingly, his teams do considerable passing. To augment his aerial game, MacDonald brought in Rich O'Hara, who lettered two years at Iowa and was the second leading receiver in the Big Ten, to provide another target for QB Jim Velasquez.

The Lumberjacks opened the 1967 campaign with an impressive 39 - 10 rout of North Dakota University,

before losing by a whisker to Weber College of Utah, 29 - 28. Key man in the Arizona rushing unit is sophomore tailback Chris Thornton, who checks in at a quick 205 pounds.

Poet coach John Godfrey saw improvement in all facets of the Poet game at Cal Poly and was particularly pleased at the offense generated in the second half. "We scored the first four times we got the ball after the intermission, primarily because our running game headed by Ross Stewart loosened up the Poly defense so our touchdown passes clicked."

Junior Pat Ferguson, who has clinched the starting quarterback job, completed seven of 10 aerials. His favorite target was Rich Bergenthal, former Pioneer High star, who hauled in two for touchdowns, covering 35 and 51 yards.

Stewart rushed for 143 yards in 35 carries against Cal Poly, but the sturdy Poet junior will be confronted by a formidable Lumberjack defensive line, averaging 244 pounds and augmented by a 267-pound linebacker, Don Sam, from Long Beach.






