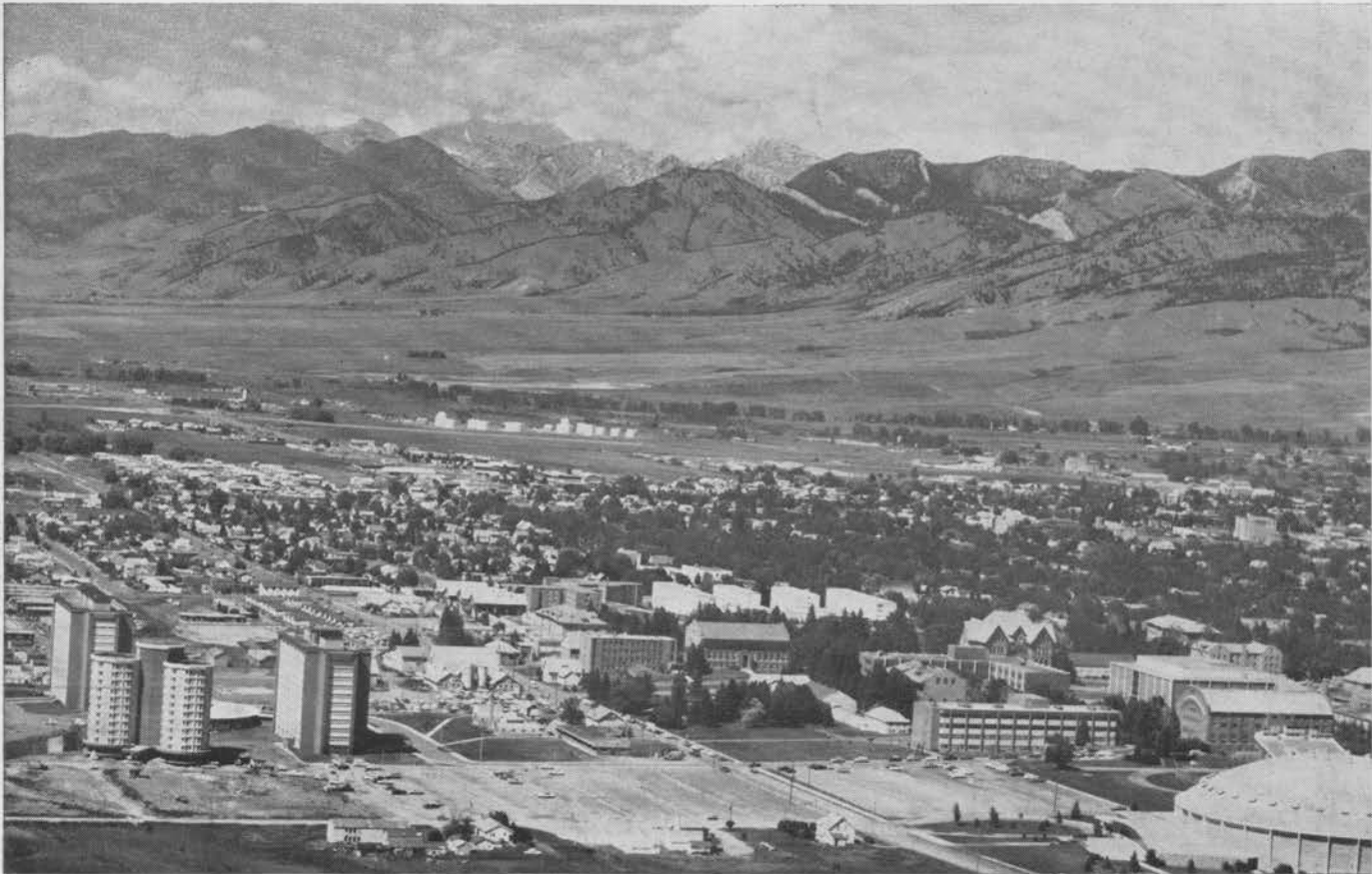

## Fifteen Bobcats Play Final Home Game

Fifteen Montana State football players will be making their final home appearances here today against the Northern Arizona University Lumberjacks.

They're seniors Jon McElroy, Ron Bain, Terry Brown, Bill Fieldstead, Bob Womack, Dennis Erickson, Sandy Coopridner, Rod Purdom, Lewie Roberts, Don Valerio, Ray Becky, Tony Welzenbach, Purnal Whitehead, Garth Forney and Don Mathern. Another senior, Randy Pedersen, was hurt in a summer accident and has redshirted this season. He plans to play for the 1969 Bobcats, however.

The 1968 seniors have been winners at Montana State. They helped the Bobcats win Big Sky titles in both 1966 and 1967 and they still have a chance to at least tie for the 1968 crown. Never has MSU had a group that'll be any more difficult to replace than this one.

Today's game matches teams with a couple of things in common. Both are 3-3 for the year. And they lost to Weber State by identical scores of 20-14.

Mike Olson, junior quarterback, triggers the NAU offense. Carrying the brunt of the running attack is Sonny Campbell, a junior tailback. Last week against San Fernando Valley State, he carried 32 times for 113 yards and caught two passes for touchdowns.

MSU and NAU have met twice before. The Bobcats won 27-6 in 1962 at Flagstaff, Ariz., and 28-7 in 1963 at Gatton Field.

Coach Tom Parac and his Bobcats aren't taking this game lightly, however. Northern has managed to hold its own against Big Sky teams. And the Bobcats know they must play well against any team which whipped Northern Illinois 43-14 just two weeks ago.

# Bobcat Coach Tom Parac



Tom Parac was elevated to the head job at Montana State last January after serving as a key Bobcat assistant coach for 11 years. A 1954 graduate of MSU, he is the first alumnus to be named head football coach at his alma mater since Schubert Dyche was appointed to the job in 1928.

Parac, 36, has had a long career at MSU. Except for service as an Army artillery officer, he has been at MSU continuously since 1950. His 11 years as an assistant covered the most successful era of football in MSU history. During that time he worked with the three most successful men ever to coach MSU football teams.

In the early 50s Parac was a star football quarterback and basketball guard for the Bobcats. He was an all-Rocky Mountain Conference selection in both sports.

He joined the staff in 1957 as freshman coach (his team posted a 4-2 record). In 1958 he became varsity backfield coach. He was named first assistant in 1963 and continued to work with the backs.

He is married to the former Artie Foster of Bozeman. They have two children.
