## TODAY'S GAME

Northern Arizona University will be meeting Whitworth College of Spokane, Washington in the first annual Band Day. Whitworth will bring an 0-5 record into the game; however, the Pirates have juggled their lineup and if they can get a consistent defensive performance, they could give NAU a tough game. This will be NAU's next-to-last home game of the season. The Lumberjacks have been ranked nationally all season; however, last week's 23-15 loss to Long Beach State will most likely knock NAU out of the rankings. NAU's defense will have to stop the Pirate quarterback, 6-1, 215-pound Tom Ingles who has accumulated almost 600 yards in total offense and has scored four TD's. Split end Jim Simonson has 17 receptions while Doug Curtis has hauled in seven passes for 77 yards and two scores.

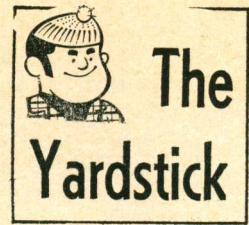
The Pirates were kingpins of the Evergreen conference in the early 1960's and participated in the NAIA post-season playoffs.

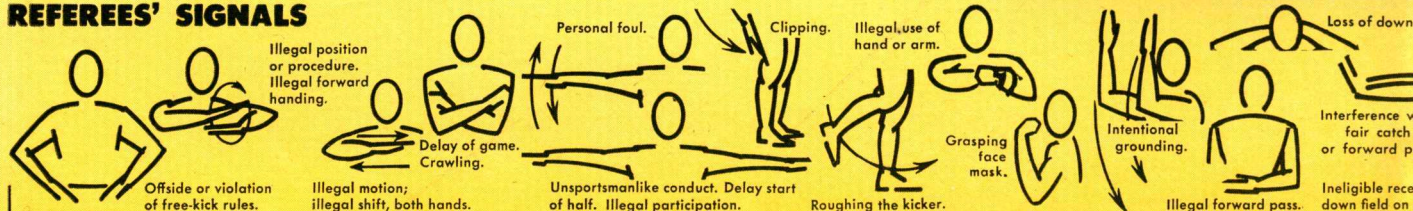
