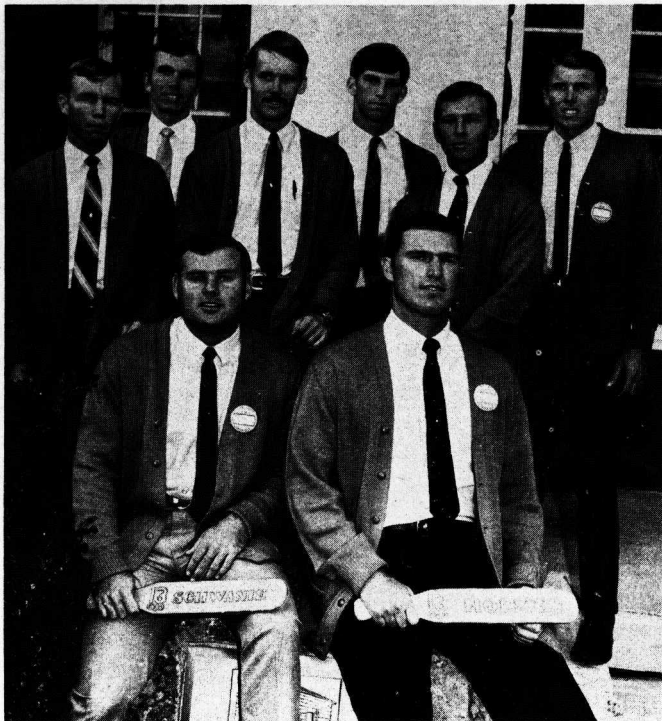

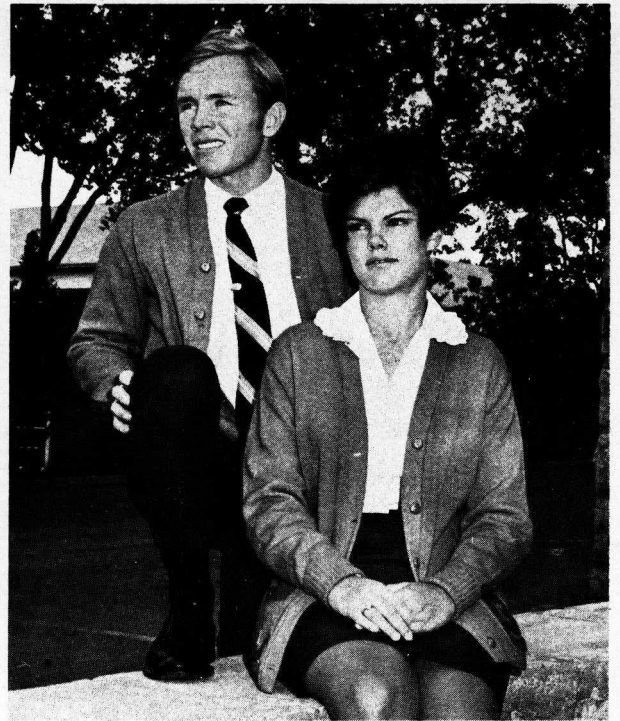

TODAY'S GAME

Northern Arizona University will be meeting one of its toughest Homecoming foes in history today when the Lumberjacks battle the Montana State University Bobcats.

Both teams lost last week, Montana State was upened by Fresno State, 28-20, while Northern Arizona University was being defeated 52-7 by the University of Montana in Missoula. NAU will take a 2-1 record into the game while Montana State has won one of three games. Portland State upset the Bobcats, 22-6, in the season-opener and two weeks ago the Bobcats defeated North Dakota University, 36-16.

In three previous meetings, the Lumberjacks have failed to beat Montana State. Last year the Bobcats tripped NAU, 20-15, at home. In 1962 Montana State won 27-6 and the following year the Bobcats belted the Lumberjacks, 28-7.

Montana State is three-time defending Big Sky Champion and the Bobcats have played in two bowl games over the last five years. Montana State is rebuilding this year and the Bobcats of Coach Tom Parac have an abundance of young talent and they are capable of putting a good game together on any given Saturday.
