TODAY'S GAME

In helping launch the 100th year of collegiate football across the nation, Northern Arizona University has built up a strong tradition as one of the finest small college teams in the Rocky Mountain West.

Over the last 13 seasons, NAU teams have compiled a very fine 81-41-6 record while suffering just one losing season along the line -- a 3-5-1 record in 1961. Much of NAU's success has been achieved with Arizona football players and 1969 will be no exception as more than 20 Arizonans are on the Lumberjack roster.

Today's game will match an eager NAU team against a California Polytechnic (Cal Poly) College of Pomona team that has a better team than its 14-game losing streak might indicate. By comparative scores, the Axers and Broncos are close. Last fall NAU nipped Long Beach 26-20 and the following week Long Beach had to rally to upend the Broncos 12-7.

Over the years, NAU leads the series with the Broncos 6-3-2 and the Lumberjacks have won the last four games between the two schools, the last being 26-0 in 1966 in Pomona.

Today's game will also introduce a new coaching staff to the Lumberjack followers. Head Coach John Symank and assistants Lamar McHan and C.O. Brocato. Symank played for six years with the Green Bay Packers as a starting safety, including two years when the Packers won NFL titles. McHan was a pro quarterback for 10 years and was runner-up to Notre Dame's Johnny Lattner for the 1953 Heisman Trophy. Brocato was captain his senior year at Baylor University where he was a three-year letterman as a linebacker and before coming to NAU, he was one of Louisiana's top high school coaches.

Brocato and McHan, who played at the University of Arkansas, were foes during their playing days; however, today, in their first games as college coaches -- they will be on the same side of the fence.

Symank graduated from the University of Florida after playing his first two years at Arlington State Junior College, now the University of Texas at Arlington.
