

# Loggers Pick Leaders

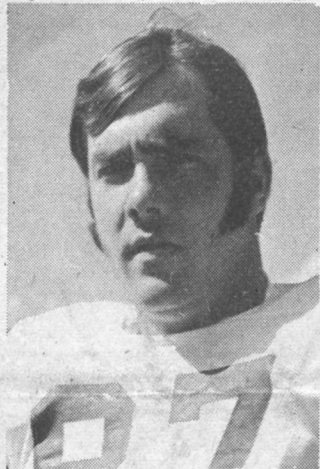
The 1970 Lumberjacks have picked their new leaders for the season naming Rick Sathoff as captain of the squad.

Also selected as his two-co-captains were quarterback Jim

Stewart but combined with Bob Brown in the Montana game to log the longest touchdown pass in the history of the college. It went for a total of 87 yards. He is from Montrose, Calif., and

transferred to NAU from Glendale Community College.

Sathoff, a 6-5 defensive tackle, appears to be the finest tackle ever to wear the 'Blue and Gold.' He went to school at Alhambra High, Phoenix, and red-shirted last season for the Axers. He weighs 260 pounds, is a senior and one of the fiercest tacklers in college ball.

A three-year letterman, Maier stands at 6-3, 205 pounds and has moved from the tight end position last season to cover the flanker-back spot, taking over where Charlie Brown left off. He is from Shelby High School, Shelby, Ohio.

Beckenhauer was the number two QB last year behind Bob
