Northern Arizona University was established in 1899 with a total of 23 students. It has passed through various growth phases over the years. The institution's total enrollment is expected to reach over 9,300 this fall.

The University, fully accredited, offers a broad, liberal arts education through its Colleges of Arts and Science, Education, Business Administration, Creative Arts, Engineering, its Schools of Forestry, and Applied Science and Technology, its College of Scientific and Humanistic Studies, and its Graduate College.

Located near the center of Flagstaff on Northern Arizona's 6,800-foot-high Coconino Plateau, the University's 677-acre, tree-shaded campus is noted for its green beauty. It sprawls in the shadow of the 12,800-foot San Francisco Peaks and within the Coconino National Forest, the largest stand of majestic Ponderosa pine in the world.

During the past decade the University has experienced phenomenal growth in enrollment and in importance to the educational system of Arizona. And, with that growth the concept of maintaining a close relationship between faculty and student (a personal university) has become more and more difficult to maintain.

More than eight years ago and anticipating the growth that was to come, President J. Lawrence Walkup and a committee of faculty members

and administrative aides initiated the "Academic Center" concept to the university's particular need of maintaining that "personal university."

This past year the first phase of the Academic Center of Northern Arizona University became a reality. The new 90-acre center—South Campus—approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile from the present campus—is made up of eight buildings constructed at a cost of more than \$10 million. A ninth building is currently under construction.

The new Academic Center will have students in the College of Scientific and Humanistic Studies, colleges of Engineering and Business Administration with the completion of the Engineering Building (now under construction), and the proposed Business Administration Building.

Each Academic Center is virtually a self-contained community under its Provost, and will also be an integral part of the University and will function under policies set by the University president.

The present campus will be stabilized at about 8,400 students, and future growth and physical growth will be on the new Academic Center.

A total of 14 buildings is planned for the new Center, that will, by 1976 at the latest, serve 4,000 students pursuing academic programs in the areas of Liberal Arts, Business Administration and Engineering and Technology.
