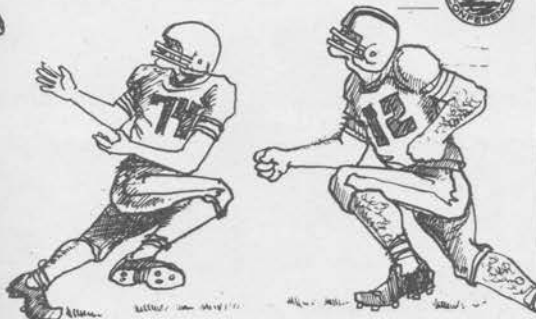

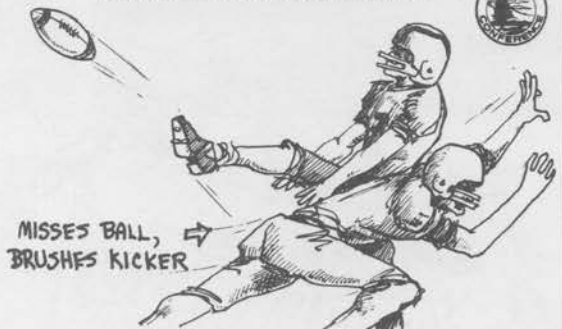


Rules from the BIG SKY



RULE 7-3-8: No. 12 will be guilty of pass interference if he runs into No. 74 before the ball reaches No. 74. If he touches the ball before contacting the man, the contact is ignored.

Rules from the BIG SKY



MISSES BALL, BRUSHES KICKER

RULE 9-1-3: Deciding if there is a foul for roughing the kicker is a matter of judgment. It is doubtful that, when a defensive player tries to avoid the kicker as here, and then brushes him, there is a foul.

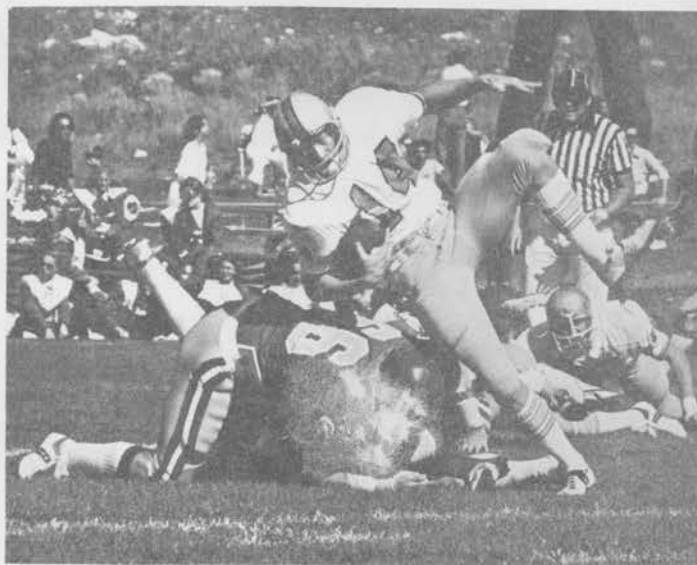

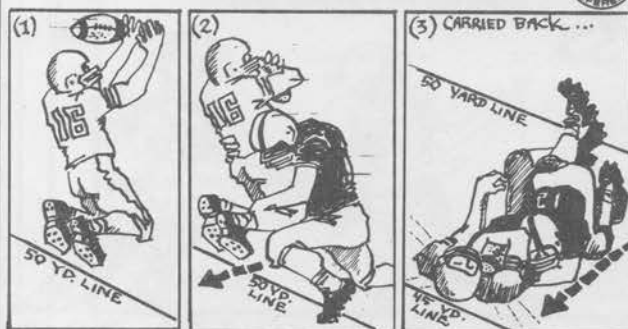


Rules from the BIG SKY



RULE 8-2-1. When any part of the ball, while in possession of a runner, passes over the goal line, touches the goal line, or penetrates an imaginary vertical wall above the goal line, it is a touchdown.

Rules from the BIG SKY



RULE 4-1-3a. No. 16 leaps in the air and gets possession of the pass beyond the 50 yard line; he is tackled and carried back behind the 50 to the 45. The ball is marked at the point where the ball was when No. 16 was tackled in (2).

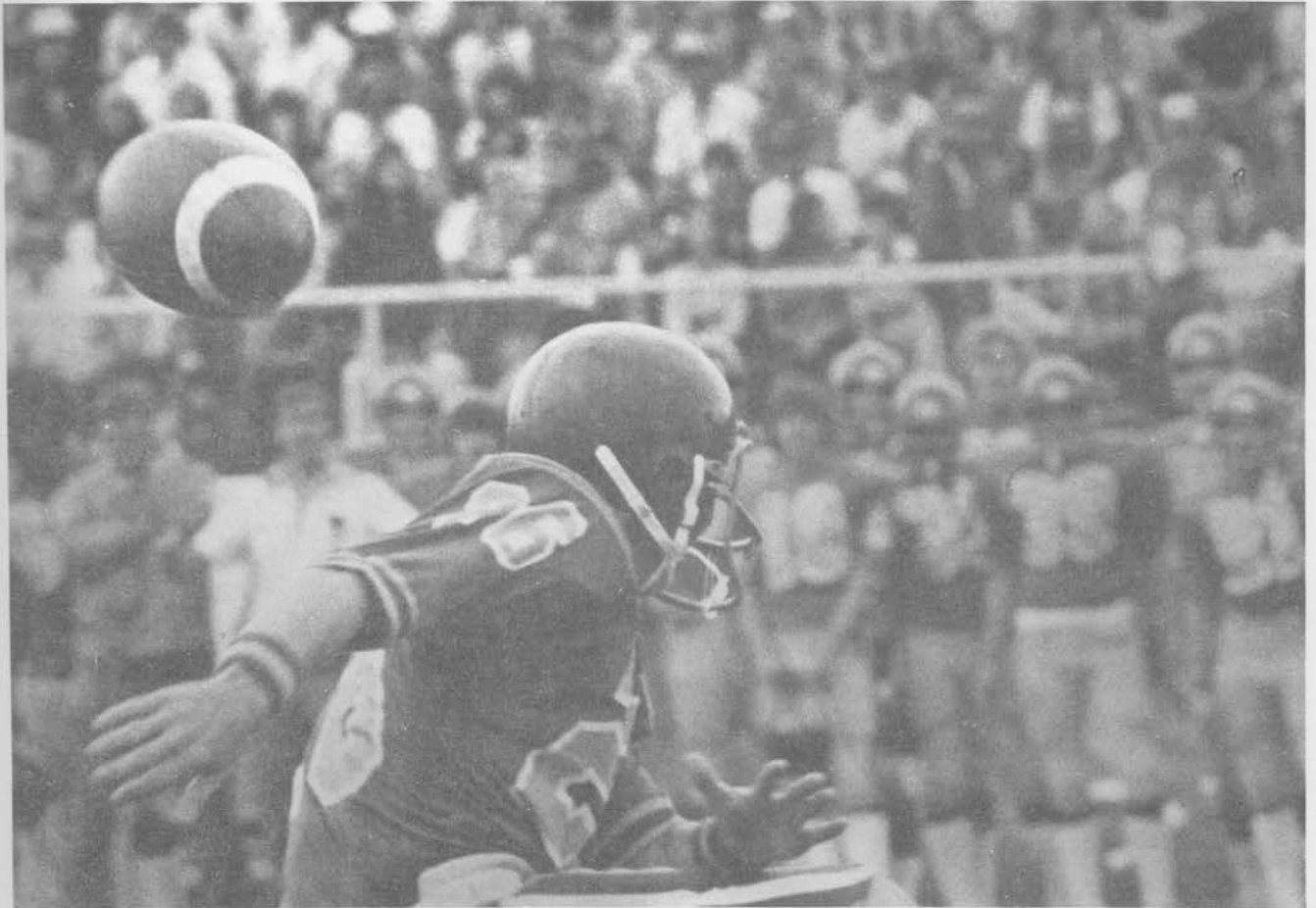

RULE 9-3-5. This is a foul (15 yards) since No. 47 positioned himself on the shoulders of a teammate prior to the snap. If he had leaped to his teammate's shoulder after the snap, it would have been legal.

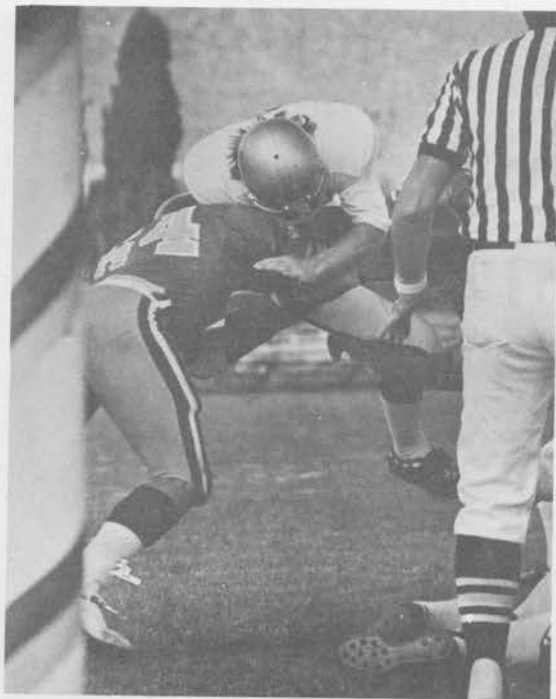




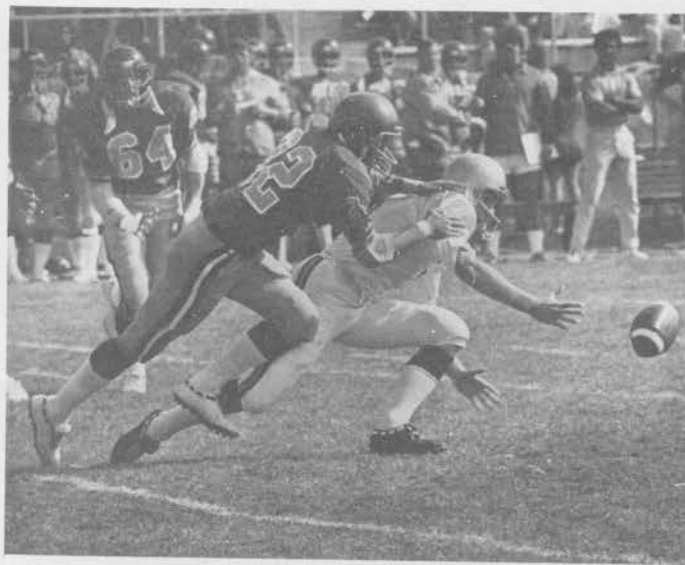
RULE 4-3-h. When a live ball touches anything inbounds other than a player, official, or the ground, it is declared dead.

Rules from the BIG SKY



① FAIR CATCH SIGNAL



② CATCHES PUNT



③ RUNS WITH BALL

RULE 6-5-2. No player of any team which has signaled a fair catch may advance with the ball more than two steps after the catch. Penalty — 5 yards. The official blows his whistle and kills the ball when a fair catch has been completed.

Rules from the BIG SKY



← FUMBLED BALL

RULE 9-3-6A. Legal. A player who is eligible to touch a loose ball and is trying to get at it may use his hand and arm extended to ward off or push an opponent out of the way.
