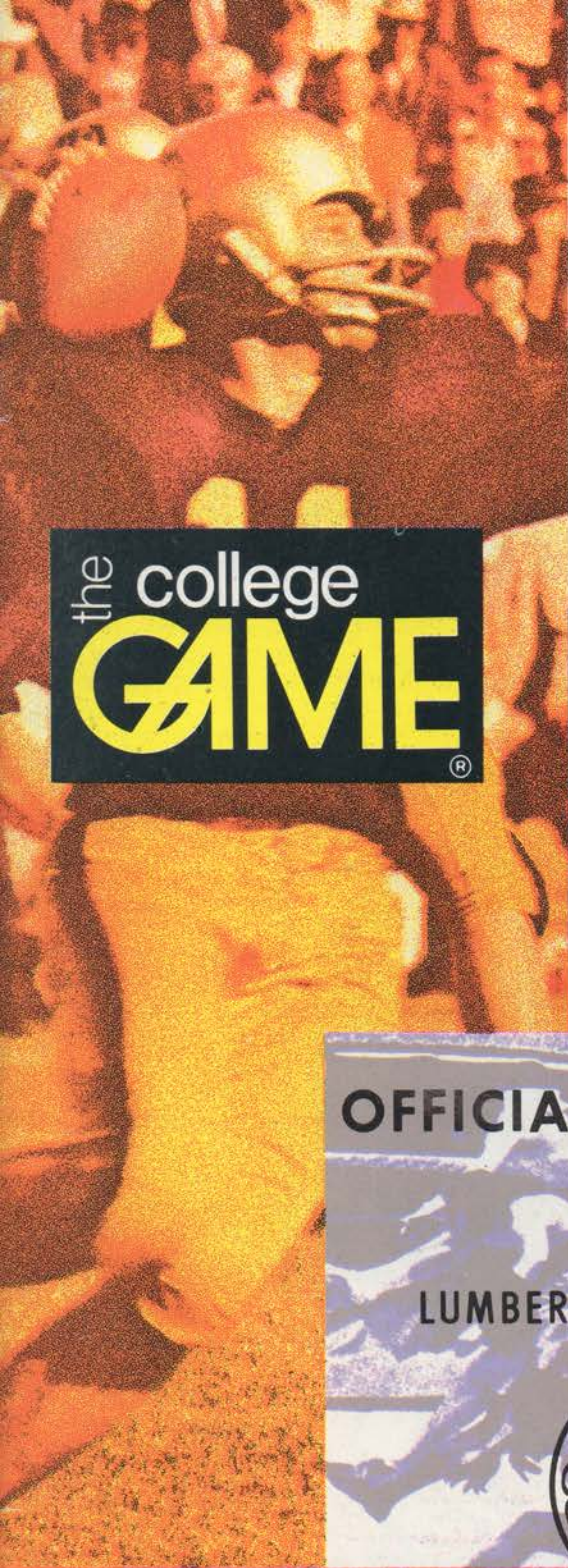

# TODAY'S GAME

The University of California-Riverside should be one of College football's top Division II teams this fall as the Highlanders return 20 starters from last year's 8-3 team which won the California Athletic Association title with a perfect 4-0 record.

The habit of winning is contagious and UC-Riverside is coming off 8-3, 8-2 and 9-1 finishes. Moving the football and putting points on the scoreboard is something Coach Bob Toledo did as a player at San Francisco State and his teams in high school and college are also explosive.

NAU has not won a season-opener since the Axers upset the potent Quantico Marines, 25-3, to launch the 1970 season and a tough season-opener has always been on NAU's schedule and this year is no exception.



Quarterback Dan Hayes (11) is the trigger man for the Highlander offense as the 6-1, 190-pound senior passed for 1,897 yards and 15 TD's last fall and he ranked fourth nationally among Division II passers with 135 completions.

Hayes' top target is Butch Johnson (1) a 6-2, 186-pound senior who caught 50 passes for 841 yards and seven TD's. Johnson ranked eighth nationally among Division II receivers.

Fullback Jeff Jones (34) led UCR in rushing last fall with 465 yards while tailback Darryl Logans (42) was close behind with 463 yards. Frank Jordan (3) a 5-9, 162-pound sophomore place-kicker will be on hand to add to his honors of a year ago when he booted all 27 conversion attempts and 12 of 16 field goals.

Leading the offensive line will be Howard Gardner (74) 6-6, 245-pound junior tackle, Tony Lottice (53), 6-2, 230-pound junior center and Larry Rowe (72) 6-2, 230-pound junior guard.

Top defenders include George Chance (40) 6-0, 190-pound senior strong safety, Jimmy Nichols (63) 6-0, 210-pound senior middle guard, linebacker Chris Rice (90) 6-2, 218-pound sophomore and linebacker Genero Hukins (36) a 6-3, 205-pound senior.

**NEXT WEEK:** NAU will play the University of Idaho next week in a 2:30 p.m. contest which will be NAU's Homecoming contest. The Vandals and NAU will be meeting for the first time in football.

Idaho opens its season tonight against Arkansas State in Jonesboro, Ark., and the Indians are one of the top teams in the Southland Conference.

This will be the first of two trips to Arizona this fall for Idaho as the Vandals will be in Tempe to meet Arizona State two weeks from today.
