NAU DOME INFORMATION

TICKETS: NAU's athletic ticket office is located on the west side of the NAU Dome on the south end of the main athletic offices. Tickets are on sale from 8 am to 5 pm weekdays and the ticket offices (both sides of the Dome) will open 1½ hours before all home games. PHONE (602) 523-5353.

TICKET OUTLETS: Ticket outlets in Flagstaff are at Athlete's Foot (University Plaza), Bankrupt Liquors (next to Granny's Closet), Darrell's Men's Wear (North 4th Street), Leamon's Appliances (North Humphreys), and Redwood Inn (Greenlaw Shopping Center). All ticket outlets will sell individual-game tickets for all home games.

PUBLIC ADDRESS: Emergency messages announced only.

NEXT OPPONENT

Should NAU beat Nevada-Reno tonight, the Lumber-jacks will be in prime contention to participate in the NCAA Division 1-AA post-season playoffs. The selection committee will name the four teams sometime early next week and where the first round will be played on Dec. 8.

The two first round games will be played on the campus of two of the participants then the championship

game will be played Dec. 15 in Orlando, Florida. A win by Nevada-Reno would leave the Wolfpack in contention for the Western Bid. Last year UNR was ranked No. 1 in the final NCAA 1-AA poll but fell to Massachusetts 44-21 in the first round at Reno.

Other prime teams considered for the playoffs include Boston University from the East, Grambling, Murray State and Eastern Kentucky from the South. Last season Florida A&M beat Jackson State 15-10 in the other first round game then Florida A&M won the first-ever NCAA 1-AA national title by beating Massachusetts 35-28.

LUMBERJACK BASKETBALL: The Lumberjack basketball team will launch its 26-game season at home next Satur-



day (Dec. 1) when Cal-Fullerton comes to town for a 7:30 p.m. game. NAU will then host the University of South Dakota Monday, Dec. 3. NAU also plays at home Thursday, Dec. 6 against Doane College and Friday, Dec. 7 against Cal-Irvine.

Last season NAU posted a 13-14 record and the Lumberjacks tied for second place at the end of regular-season Big Sky Conference action

with Idaho State — each team having an 8-6 record. NAU then finished runner-up to Weber State in the Big Sky Tourney — one step away from the NCAA playoffs.

NAU will be paced by three seniors this season — all of whom started last season. Mark Stevens, 6-6, 210-pound forward from Scottsdale was NAU's leading scorer (15.4) and rebounder (9.0) last season while Wayne Wharton, 6-5, 190-pound forward had 13.1 scoring clip and a 5.2 rebounding norm. Johnson averaged 6.6 points and 1.8 rebounds a game. Other returnees from NAU's "Hard-Way 8" team of a year ago include 6-9 234-pound junior center Mike Evans and 6-6 sophomore forward Ted Plotts.
